There currently are water and wastewater services available to the property. Based on our records, there should be a 5/8" water meter on site for the property. A wastewater service line should also be available at the property line; however, the property was originally on a septic system and was never "cut-over" to city wastewater. There will be a connection fee associated with the cut-over process. More detailed information on the property and what is in place or will be placed on it will be needed to accurately quote any applicable fees.
